2012 ADOSH Regional Safety Summit

The Summit will include an OSHA 10-Hour class for employees and a number of management, small business and general safety classes. (Click here to see the flyer) In Yuma we will offer a General Industry class. This is an OTI Outreach class and will require two full days attendance for attendees to receive a certification card. There are only 40 seats available and each business can enroll a maximum of five employees.
