

Yuma County Labor Statistics

In Yuma County, 31.4% of the population is estimated to be employed and age 16 and over for the current year. The employment status of this labor force is:

- 2.56% are in the Armed Forces
- 47.06% are employed civilians
- 4.82% are unemployed civilians
- 45.56% are not in the labor force

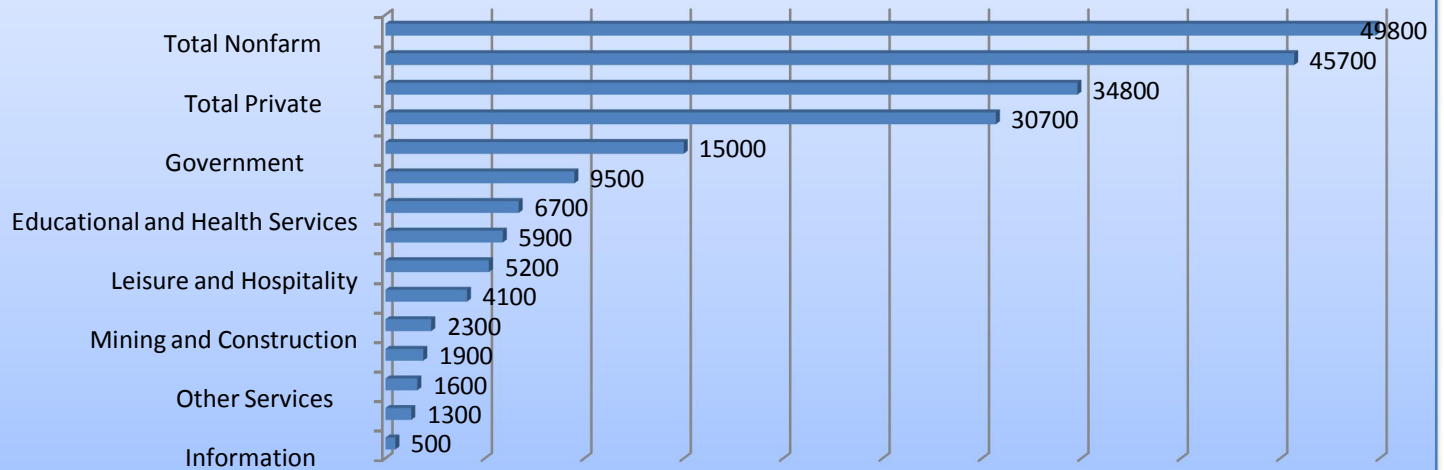

For the civilian employed population age 16 and over in Yuma County, it is estimated that they are employed in the following occupational categories:

0.9% are in Architecture and Engineering, 1.0% are in Arts, Entertainment and Sports, 2.6% are in Business and Financial Operations, 0.7% are in Computers and Mathematics, 6.3% are in Education, Training and Libraries, 4.0% are in Healthcare Practitioners and Technicians, 1.9% are in Healthcare Support, 0.4% are in Life, Physical and Social Sciences, 7.3% are in Management, 14.4% are in Office and Administrative Support, 1.5% are in Community and Social Services, 6.3% are in Food Preparation and Serving, 1.1% are in Legal Services, 4.4% are in Protective Services, 9.6% are in Sales and Related Services, 4.2% are in Personal Care Services, 4.8% are in Building and Grounds Maintenance, 7.1% are in Construction and Extraction, 5.4% are in Farming, Fishing and Forestry.
