



YPIC Training Reimbursement

Yuma Private Industry Council (YPIC) will handle everything from start to finish, for the employer. They will recruit applicants, screen them according to standards set individually by you (the company), test them for the skills they need to fill the position, assist you with the interview process, and will provide training to employees on skills specific to your business. All this is done at a nominal fee.

YPIC will reimburse up to 50% of the employees OJT (On the Job Training) provided by the Company, for up to six (6) months or 499 hours; whichever is more, for employees that meet the minimum requirements.

Minimum Requirements

- 1. Must receive or be a member of a family which receives cash welfare payments under Federal, State or Local welfare programs**
- 2. Have received or be a member of a family that received a total family income this is not in excess of 70% of the lower living standard income level**
- 3. Received food stamps or has been determined eligible within six (6) months prior to application pursuant to the Food Stamp Act of 1977**
- 4. Is or has been homeless or a foster child on behalf of whom State of Local government payments are made**
- 5. Have a disability that is a substantial barrier to employment**

Each employee will have a contract with YPIC and you, the employer for one year.

YPIC will screen all applicants to ensure they meet these criteria. You, the company are eligible for this service immediately.
